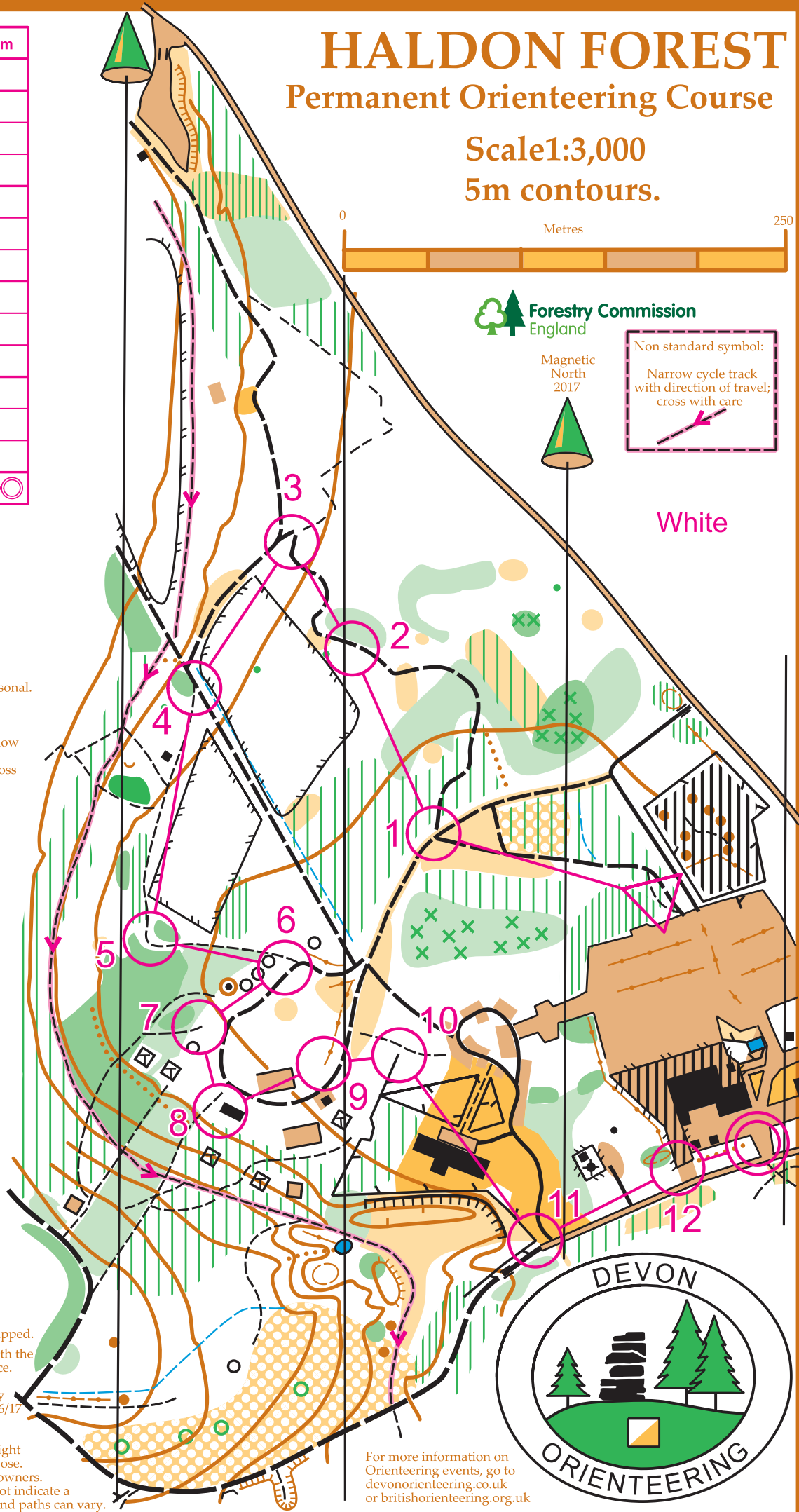
Magnetic North 2017
