Magnetic North 2017

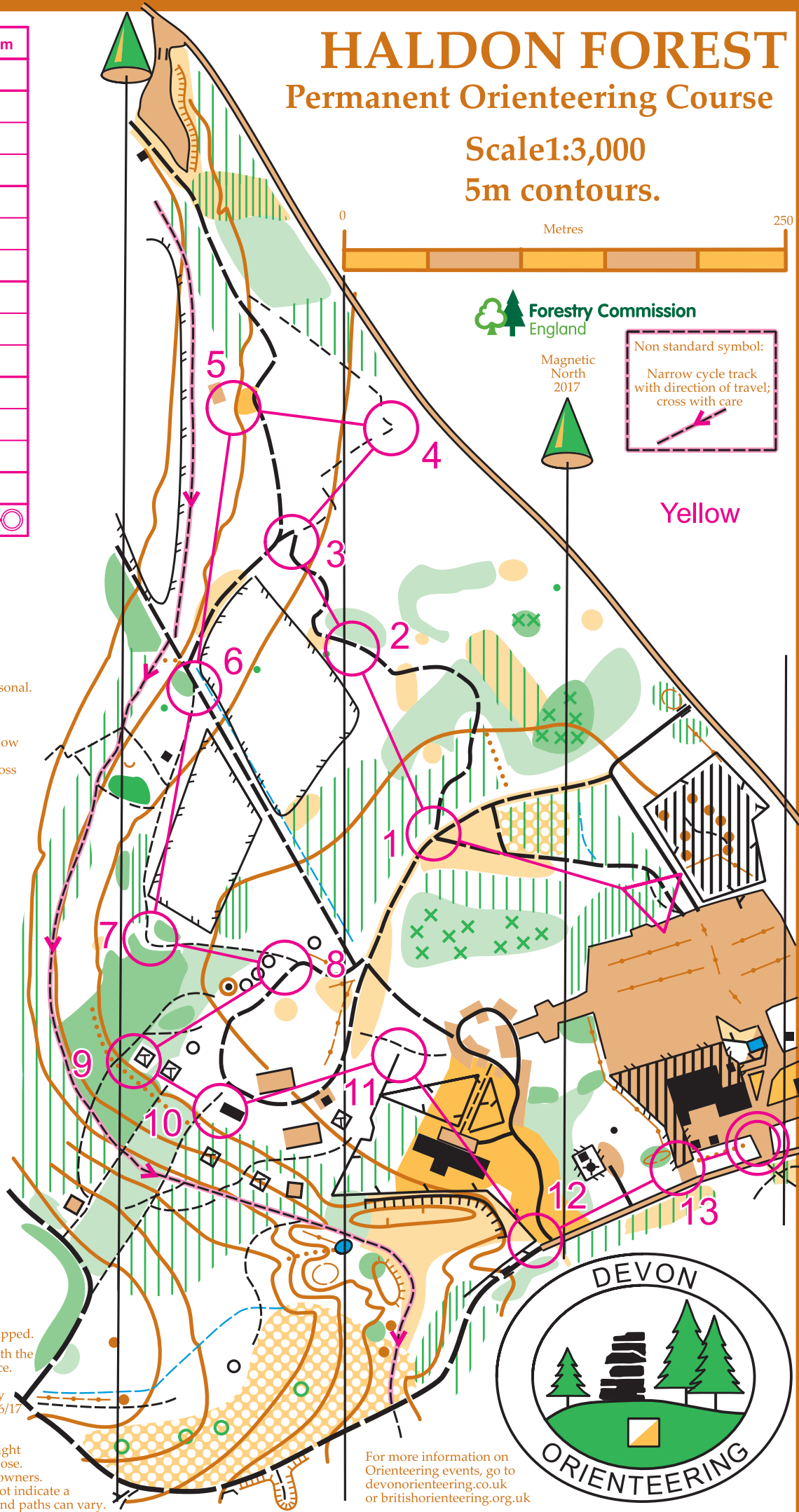
Non standard symbol:
