Parke, National Trust – Bovey Tracey

General Information: This is a local event hosted on the grounds of Parke National Trust, Bovey Tracey. The terrain is parkland and woodland with a strong path network, and is very suitable for beginners and experienced runners alike!

Parking and Directions: Competitors to use the nearby Station Road carpark (fees apply), TQ13 9AW Bovey Tracey (what3words vote.detective.acclaimed, with a signed 1.3km walk to the registration tent. Alternatively, if you have more than 1 person in the vehicle you can use the on-site National Trust carpark (fees apply) (what3words proper.stardom.knees). Registration will be sign posted from both carparks and is located at what3words mason.snowboard.knees. There will be a tent area to store bags and belongings while running.

Terrain: National Trust parkland and some recently re-mapped woodland.

Start times 10:30 to 13:00

Courses close 14:00 (all runners to be finished by this time)

Two Courses to choose from:

- **45 minute score course** – visit controls in any order to collect points; points are based on the control number*. This is a shorter easier course, suitable for beginners.
- **60 minute Odds/Evens score course** – you decide whether to collect odd or even controls first, then during the 60 mins you decide when best to switch to collect the opposite (you can only switch once). Points are based on the control number*.

** 20 points deducted from your score for every minute you return late!*

Entry details: Pre-entry via <http://www.racesignup.co.uk> with entries closing 12th March. Fees are £10 for seniors, £3 for juniors, £6 for family groups.

Facilities: Toilets at Station Road carpark. Toilets and café at the Parke centre, which is near Registration. First Aid will be at registration.
