

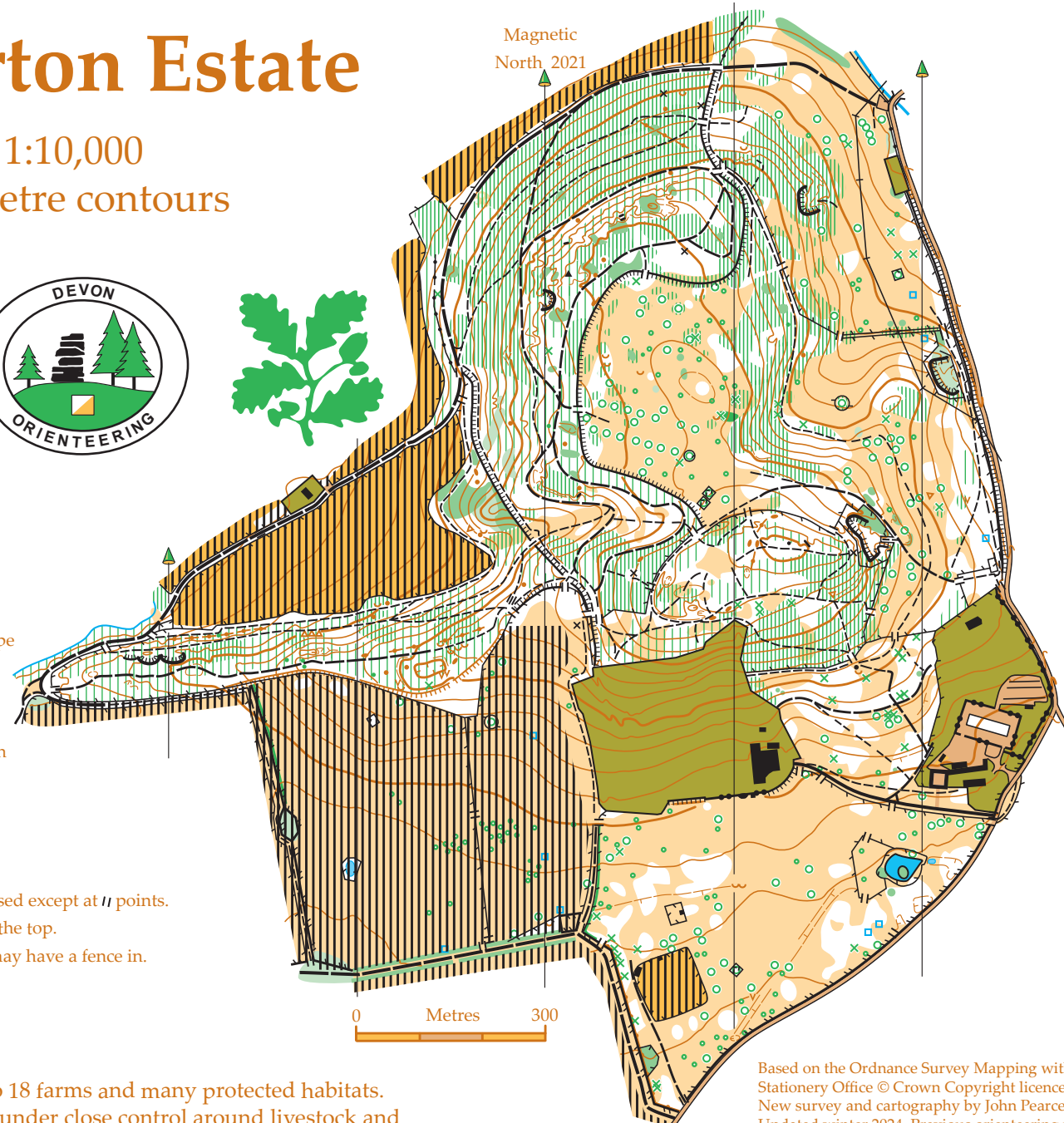

Small cliff features must not be crossed except at // points.
They may be flat or have a bank on the top.
There is a gully at the base, which may have a fence in.



Killerton's 10sq mile estate is home to 18 farms and many protected habitats. Please keep dogs on a short lead and under close control around livestock and wash hands and shoes if coming into contact with animal faeces. Ticks, although rare, are also present.
