

# Novelty score event – Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> December 2018

- ☺ There will be a mass start at 11.00 am.
- ☺ There are no punches or dibbers at the controls, so you will need a pen to write down a letter at each control and to answer some seasonal questions.
- ☺ You have 60 minutes to find up to 30 control points marked on the map.
- ☺ We have used 20 permanent control posts (left) & 10 orange & white control flags (right).



- ☺ You will have a control description sheet showing the control number to check you have found the right control. For example, you may be looking for control number 30 shown on your map, but when you get to the control it may show number 87 (as above); check your control description to ensure you are at the right control. There are a lot of other permanent control posts in the forest which are not for you to visit on this occasion - but do come back another time, buy a map and visit them.
- ☺ Use the Christmas tree grid on the back of your map, to record that you have found the control. In the appropriate numbered box write the letter that is in the top left-hand corner of the post. For the post illustrated the letter P would be written.
- ☺ At each of the 10 traditional orange and white orienteering control flags there is a multiple-choice Christmas tree trivia question. Answer the question by writing a, b, c, or d in appropriate numbered box on the back of your map.
- ☺ Scoring - 1 point for every control you find  
1 point for every question you get right
- ⊗ 2 points will be deducted for every minute you take over 60 minutes

**You must hand in your map, with your name clearly written, at the finish to prove we have you back safely, and to add up your points scored.**

**You will get your map back once the score has been recorded.**
